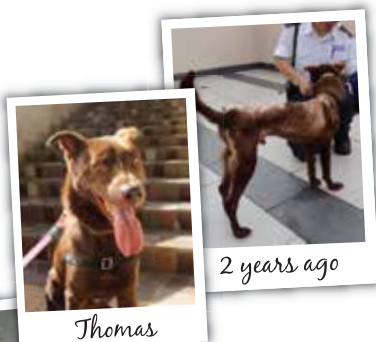



Our Mission

SPCA Case Files

Over the last 2.5 years, Thomas had recovered both physically and emotionally with our tender loving care, and we were succeeded in finding him new home finally.

In a week in December 2015, our veterinary team travelled all the way to Peng Chau, and had provided 53 desexing operations and 44 vaccinations to the dogs and cats of the local residents.



The Society for the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals established in 1903 devotes itself to promoting animal welfare in Hong Kong and the region. Even though we are the longest standing animal welfare charity in Hong Kong (being officially registered in 1921) and make a significant contribution, we receive virtually no financial support (less than 1% of total income) from the government. We need the moral and financial support of the public and rely heavily on individual donations, membership subscriptions, and income from fundraising events and our services to continue in our mission to care for animals and improve their welfare. Why become a SPCA Member?

Over the last 95 years, the SPCA has been the driving force behind animal protection in Hong Kong; focusing on both the preventing of cruelty to and improving the welfare of animals. Membership Types

Applicants must be at least 16 years of age. Individuals who are under 16 are welcome to join as Junior Members. All regular memberships (except Life-term Membership) have a minimum term of one year with renewal upon expiration.

This individual membership is designed for young people who are under 16 and only applicable to consultations for pocket pets, such as rabbits, guinea pigs and hamsters. Junior members are required to be accompanied by their parents when visiting our Veterinary Services.

Member Privileges

Below services and benefits are member exclusive. A fee is required on the service employed. All fees after cost will be used to fund animal welfare work.



Pawprint Newsletter

All members are entitled to a free subscription of Pawprint, the SPCA's quarterly newsletter. It highlights the latest trends, work of the Society, membership activities as well as current animal welfare issues.

Veterinary Services

As a member, your pets can use the SPCA's veterinary services including consultation, surgery, dentistry, diagnostic imaging, laboratory and hospitalisation. If your pet has an emergency our hospital in Wanchai is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year to provide fast, comprehensive and compassionate care.

Boarding

Our boarding service for dogs and cats is offered exclusively to members. Dedicated kennel staff together with onsite veterinary facilities care for your companion animals while you are away giving you peace of mind.

Grooming

Members are offered special discounts for using the professional grooming services provided by SPCA centres.

Animal Behaviour Training Classes

The SPCA promotes a "Positive Reinforcement" method of training for dogs so that they are well behaved. Members are entitled to special discounts when enrolling on training courses.

Retail Shop Sales

Members purchasing pet foods and accessories at SPCA retail shops can enjoy 10% discount and special offers on certain promotional items.

Special Events

The SPCA hosts a wide range of events for its members e.g. seminars, workshops and pet carnivals. Some of these are exclusive for members.

For the Community

1. Humane Education and Information

The Society deeply believes that educating the public can improve animal welfare and prevent suffering and cruelty. The Society regularly hosts seminars to spread the message of care and respect for animals to people of different ages. Besides regular school visits, we also encourage visits to any of our adoption centres to understand our work and services.

2. 24-Hour Rescue Hotline

The SPCA Inspectorate is the only rescue team that provides 24/7 emergency rescue service to animals in Hong Kong, Kowloon, the New Territories, and outlying islands. Our team of 30 Inspectors respond to calls for help, collect or rescue animals, animal trading inspections at wet markets and pet shops, and investigate complaints of cruelty. They will give warnings and even instigate prosecutions with the assistance of the police.

3. Cat Colony Care Programme

The Society is working towards street cat populations and associated welfare issues. Our volunteer cat colony carers work hand in hand with SPCA staff in capturing feral cats, neutering, and finally releasing them back to the 1,400 managed cat colonies. During the past 15 years, we have de-sexed over 59,000 street cats. We believe that neutering feral cats is the most humane way of preventing future generations from suffering on the streets of Hong Kong.

4. Welfare Research, Lobbying & Advance

Science based research helps us better identify and define the needs of animals, leading to a higher level of husbandry and care. The SPCA Welfare Department identifies and investigates deficiencies in the welfare of animals in Hong Kong including companion animals, exotic pets, farm/food animals and native wildlife. By initiating research into problem areas we can assess animal welfare in Hong Kong in the context of internationally accepted standards. This research provides the support needed to launch campaigns to improve animal welfare, to develop better management policies, or to provide a scientific basis for more rigorous animal welfare legislation.

5. Adoption

The SPCA Homing Packages include: Cat, Dog and Small Animal Packages. The cat and dog packages cover an initial health check, the initial full course of preventive vaccinations, micro-chip, deworming and desexing. The dog-package also includes a rabies vaccination and heartworm testing. Small and exotic animals such as guinea pigs, rabbits, turtles and birds also need new homes and adoption packages are tailored accordingly. Please note there is no charge made for the animal itself. Please help these unwanted animals and support our work by giving them a chance of a happy life.

6. Foster Parent Program

Become a foster parent of a young or sick animal and help us save lives. The foster period is usually from four to six weeks and at the end of the period, the animal is returned to the SPCA to be adopted into a caring home.

7. Animal Welfare Vehicle / Mobile Clinic

The mobile clinic services the need of around 3,000 companion animals per year in the areas of Shatin, Tuen Mun, Tuen Wan, and Tung Chung. It offers reduced cost services to pet owners who are unable to afford basic veterinary care. The Animal Welfare Vehicle, was made possible by the generous sponsorship of the Sir Robert Ho Tung Fund, is a purpose built, mobile surgical unit dedicated to providing low cost desexing for dogs and cats in rural areas. These mobile services are available to both members and non-members and allows the SPCA to maintain a presence in outlying areas to facilitate the promotion of animal welfare and responsible pet ownership.
